The Financial crisis is still very much with us. While efforts continue to try and stem this crisis, the world has also embarked on a longer term reform effort with bodies such as the Basel Committee, the Financial Stability Board and the G-20 all having put forward a slew of proposals. In the US, the Congress has already put forward detailed and far-reaching regulatory changes which are now in the process of being finalized. The European Union has already adopted some changes, is finalizing additional comprehensive reforms and has just laid out a time table for new proposals for additional regulation.

**Sony Kapoor**, Managing Director of Think Tank Re-Define and an expert adviser to several G-20 governments and the European Parliament will give his perspective on the state of play of regulatory reform discussions. He will discuss not only which the most significant and far reaching reforms enacted are but also what the likely path for the future of financial system reform is. Finally, he will focus on the aspects of existing and forthcoming proposals that Norway should focus on.
